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Remarks

***Actions which are directed to be taken are not all that may be required of the kennel operator to come into compliance.
The kennel operator is responsible for taking any and all actions necessary to come into compliance.***

The inspection of the kennel took place on November 14, 2019. There were 108 adult dogs and 2 puppies located on the premises and 30 adult dogs and 2 puppies listed in rescue kennel network homes at the time of this inspection. The 2019 kennel license and state forms exemption letter were viewed. The inspection was performed with State Veterinarian Dr Ward.

The inspection of November 14, 2019 is as follows:

207(b) / 21.29(c) - Housekeeping/Pests:

Warden observed rodent feces on the floor along the building walls, underneath the primary enclosures housing dogs, and in the back corner in the loading dock area. Underneath several rows of primary enclosures there was an accumulation of food and other debris. This type of environment (accumulation of debris, rodent feces, food, and trash) will continue encouraging mammalian pest infestation regardless of the type of program in place to get rid of them. The air vents on the walls and ceilings were dusty and dirty, in need of cleaning. There was a light out over the H row enclosure. In the row B enclosures the metal floor dividers are rusting and need replaced or covered.

The back loading dock area has been significantly decluttered since the previous inspection. There were multiple pest traps viewed throughout the kennel to deal with the rodent issue. Requests have been submitted to have the air vents and light serviced by the city. The row B enclosures should be replaced in February.

This warden directs that the kennel operator take the following action(s):

The buildings and grounds of kennels shall be maintained, kept clean and in good repair to protect the animal from injury and to facilitate practices required by this chapter. Kennels shall have an effective program that controls ingress by insects, ectoparasites and avian and mammalian pests. Evidence of insects, ectoparasites and avian and mammalian pests or conditions that would allow or encourage infestation in a kennel are indicative of an ineffective program and unsanitary environmental sanitation in the kennel.

**A follow up inspection will take place at a later date and time.
